AIMS & SCOPE

Constant advances in interdisciplinary approaches and complexity theories provide rising potentials for the development of academic and scientific practice. REAS attempts to enhance the presently insufficient utilisation of that potential in sciences, social sciences, humanities and other disciplines, and to strengthen the impact of **interdisciplinarity and complexity** on dealing with societal needs and problems.

REAS promotes **issues of direct social relevance** that are already the subject of various disciplines. While remaining entirely open to research done in disciplinary frameworks, REAS tries to create a setting for interdisciplinary discussion and exchange, and encourages the application of principles of interdisciplinary and complexity in dealing with the conference topics.

Envisioned as an **annual conference**, REAS is aimed primarily at **younger people** of interest: doctoral students, post-docs, young professionals, activists, etc. Besides giving insight into the conference topics and new research approaches, REAS should contribute to the creation of an active **collaborative network** between the participants.

REAS 2007

The focus of REAS 2007 is estimating the quality of actions for promoting or enhancing **human development**, and on the multiple interactions of human development with issues related, but not limited, to: discourse, policy, communities, economy, environment, communication, culture, human rights, (in)equality, education, work, health, science, technology, globalisation & regionalisation, specific regional issues.

In addition, introductory overviews or exemplary applications of new research methods are also welcome.

PROGRAMME

Programme will include oral presentations, posters and a round table discussion.

Authors are kindly requested to specify in their applications preference for oral presentation or poster. The duration of an oral presentation and related discussion is limited to 20 min.

Scientific Committee will determine presentation mode. The authors will be informed about the decision before June 15th.

Official language of REAS is English. Translation will not be organised. There is no conference fee. **Contributions will be issued** in the Conference Proceedings.
